Passengers in front of several moving baggage claims in an Italian airport. Orfeo and Olympia are coming from different countries, they are waiting for their luggage in front of a baggage claim with other passengers. Violetta and Tamino are also waiting for their luggage in front of another baggage claim with other passengers. The singers must wait for a long time for their baggage to arrive. They are tense and their movements and behaviour give us an idea as to their characters. They don't feel like they're being observed, they act and move as if they were alone. At the end of the overture, they finally get their luggage and go towards the arrival gate.
