## **NOTES**

All notation is at sounding pitch except for the parts of the Piccolo and Contrabass.

Flute, Clarinet, Flugelhorn (Trumpet) and Viola are tuned a quarter-tone lower than a = 440 Hz, and should be placed close to each other.



- *"text"* whisper indicated text
   Since the words should not be recognizable by listeners, musicians should avoid a loud "theatrical" whispering.
  - $\Box$  sing notes
    - a  $\frac{1}{4}$  tone higher, a  $\frac{3}{4}$  tone higher
  - $a^{1/4}$  tone lower,  $a^{3/4}$  tone lower
    - natural harmonics (finger position)
    - **&** artificial harmonics (fingers position)
      - produce the harmonics only with a bow playing sul ponticello
        - play on a tailpiece


